4. Seluruh pembiayaan Pelatihan akan ditanggung Pemerintah Malaysia termasuk biaya pelatihan, akomodasi dan tiket penerbangan.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the Course, participants are expected to be able to:

- ◆ Design and develop teachers' guides and lesson plans for improving teaching and learning;
- ◆ Act as mentors and/or leaders of other teachers on curriculum and subject matter issues; and
- ◆ Work collaboratively with other teachers and to reflect on best practices of mathematics education and student learning.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS

The target participants of this course are key teachers/officers currently teaching mathematics or involved in curriculum planning or supervision of mathematics programmes. Since the programme will be quite hectic, we recommend that the key teachers/officers should be in good health and preferably below 50 years of age. We would also like to recommend a gender balance in each group of participants.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should be a civil servant of Ministry of Education from the selected countries; should have practical experience in teacher education in Mathematics; should possess a minimum qualification of a diploma/degree in related discipline; should be at the age between 26 to 50 years old at the commencement of the course; women are encouraged to apply; should possess a good command of the English language (both spoken and written abilities); must be in good health both physically, mentally and certified medically fit in order to complete the course (Applicants must submit his/her medical certificate together with the application form); and must not be in the military service.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is the first time SEAMEO RECSAM will conduct this course for ASEAN countries. The course would be of benefit to teacher educators of ASEAN countries by enhancing the fullest potential of teacher educators in teaching mathematics.

This programme aims at strengthening the capacity of teacher educators in the ASEAN countries by enhancing their skills in promoting active teaching and learning in mathematics in line with the current trends in mathematics education. The participants will engage in various activities to develop Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS), design, implement and improve mathematics lessons creatively through active interaction and sharing of experiences among group members.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions of MTCP scholarship includes:

- ◆ Fares: Return air fares from the capital city of the recipient to Penang on economy class
- ◆ Course fee: All course fees will be borne by the Malaysian Government under the MTCP
- ◆ Accommodation: Participant will be staying in-campus at International House.
- ◆ Other conditions: All participants must abide by all rules and regulation of training institution. The award may be terminated at anytime due to unsatisfactory conduct, breach of condition or failure to make satisfactory progress.

COURSE VENUE AND DURATION

The course will be conducted at SEAMEO RECSAM, Penang, Malaysia for the duration of 3-weeks.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Application must be made using the standard application form obtainable from Embassies/High Commission of the Malaysian Government in the applicant's respective country or from the MTCP website.

Application must be completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs/Focal Points responsible for the MTCP Programme in the applicant's country, then submitted through the applicant's government to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Malaysia via Note Verbale from the applicant's Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

It is mandatory under MTCP for all the MTCP/TCP participants to follow the Visa With Reference (VWR) application procedure.
